LE BUREAU

cartridge (toner cartridge) (n) – cartouche
 Ex: We need to replace the toner cartridge in the photocopier.

cupboard (n) – placard
 Ex: Could you look in the cupboard for some paper clips, please?

desk (n ou adj) – bureau (meuble)
 Ex: Where are my keys? I thought I left them on my desk.

desktop (n ou adj) – bureau, de bureau (ordinateur)
 Ex: I use a desktop computer at work; I left the documents you want on the desktop.

drawer (n) - tiroir
 Ex: You will find drawing pins in the second drawer down.

drawing pin (n) – punaise
 Ex: We use drawing pins to fix papers onto the notice board.

filing cabinet (n) – classeur à tiroirs
 Ex: We keep all our archived files in the filing cabinet.

furniture (toujours singulier) (n ou adj) – meubles, mobiliers
 Ex: We buy all our office furniture from a single supplier.

glue (n) – colle
 Ex: Could you lend me your stick of glue, please?

inkjet (adj) – jet à encre
 Ex: Inkjet printers are cheaper than laser printers.

11. jam (paper jam) (n) – bourrage papier

Ex: The printer's not working; someone put the wrong sized paper in it and caused a paper jam.

keyboard (n ou adj) - clavier
 Ex: In most English-speaking countries they use a QWERTY keyboard.

13. **laptop (n ou adj)** – (ordinateur) portable

Ex: I use a desktop at work, but I always carry a laptop with me when I travel.

monitor (n) – écran
 Ex: I've bought a 21-inch monitor for my computer.

15. mouse (n ou adj) – souris

Ex: You need to right click on the mouse to obtain the menu.

paper clip (n) – trombone
 Ex: I need some paper clips to attach these documents.

stapler / staple gun (n) - agrafeuse (staples = agrafes)
 Ex: I need a bigger stapler to staple these pages.

18. **stationery (n ou adj)** – fournitures de bureau Ex: The firm buys its stationery supplies from a Dutch supplier.
